

Prohibited and Confiscation List for the University of Buckingham

There are some items that Students must not bring into the Accommodation whatsoever and there are some items that can only be used and stored in the Kitchen and should not be found in your room.

It is the university policy to confiscate items that are prohibited. Certain prohibited items marked **are more serious than others and will be reported to the Senior Tutor. These items carry a warning and/or fine and are destroyed appropriately.

- **Candles and Incense Sticks (lit or unlit) ****
- **Flares/Fireworks/Explosive Devices/Compressed Gas Canisters ****
- **Illegal drugs and paraphernalia ****

The university will confiscate prohibited items and, space allowing, hold these items until the end of your accommodation license. Items marked * in addition to ** although not dangerous cannot be stored and are thrown away

It is in your own interest therefore to ensure you check the items listed below before you arrive at University.

Items that are prohibited and not allowed in to the University

Chip pans and deep fat fryers Any item that produces a flame including BBQ's * Fridges, mini cools and freezers Washing machines and dryers Mini ovens and microwaves Heated clothes drying appliances	Air conditioning units and dehumidifiers. Amplifiers and extensive sound equipment. Portable electric heaters of any type. Shisha pipes of any type.
Drugs and paraphernalia ** Candles and Incense sticks ** Flares, fireworks, explosive devices and compressed gas canisters ** (helium, laughing gas) Plug in air fresheners * Any electrical item failing a PAT test or deemed to be immediate threat to safety *	Uplighter lamps. Mains fairy or festive lights. Motorised or petrol powered scooters and hover boards.
	Non CE marked and non-fused plugs and adaptors *
	Soft furnishings: curtains, blinds, rugs, chairs, canvas wardrobes, lampshades and electric blankets, non-university student and gaming chairs, mattresses and air beds.

Never, ever put a 2 pin plug into a UK 3 pin socket without using the correct adaptor

Cool (only) fans, small prayer and bath mats, battery operated fairy or festive lights and reed diffusers are permissible.

Items to be stored and only used in the kitchen, providing they are electrically safe:

Electric hotplates/coffee machines and kettles Rice cookers, Slow cookers and blenders	Sandwich makers, toasters and electric grills Waffle and popcorn makers

Items that may be used in accordance with university guidelines:

Smoking and vaping equipment **not inside or within 3 metres of University buildings**
Bicycles, cars, mopeds and scooters **stored outside, secured and parked appropriately**

The university reserves the right to add to or amend this list as and when required

The university cannot be held responsible for any damage to stored items that have been confiscated
